Specialty Training Year 2

**Minimum
prior to 18 month review**

3 x COT

Notes

1. The above minimum evidence refers to those undertaking a three-year run-through programme.
2. Throughout the training mini-CEX and COT assessments will be used interchangeably. The former being adopted in the secondary care setting, the latter in primary care.
3. DOPS assessment will only need to be carried out until the mandatory practical skills have been assessed as satisfactory.
4. Patient satisfaction will only be assessed in the primary care setting.
5. Multi-source feedback will involve clinical raters only when in secondary care and both clinical and non-clinical in primary care.
6. There are different arrangements for those registrars who commenced GP training before August 2007².
7. Each use of a tool is not to be seen as an assessment and there is no pass / fail for any tool. The tools simply serve to harvest information and provide the supervisor with material for feedback, identification of learning needs and possible recommendations for change for the trainee.
